We hope you have enjoyed the incredible orchestral and chamber music concerts we have presented this season in our beloved Capital City of Trenton. As we wrap up 2022-2023 and approach our tenth anniversary season, we are filled with gratitude for your unwavering support over the past decade! We hope that support will continue as we grow into the future!

While off the concert stage we have also strengthened our deep commitment to the Trenton community through our education and community outreach programs. Here are just a few highlights:

We visited the students at the International Charter School of Trenton, where musicians from our orchestra and ballet dancers from the American Repertory Ballet performed excerpts from the NUTCRACKER. We also provided these students and their families with complimentary tickets to the full performance at the War Memorial.

In the afternoon before our March concert we hosted Trenton Music Makers most advanced orchestra students. They were treated to a master class given by three of our musicians, had the opportunity to perform a curtain-raiser for our audience and were given free tickets to attend the evening performance by the CPNJ chamber orchestra.

In April renowned guitar soloist David Galvez visited the International Charter School of Trenton and Trenton Music Makers, giving an educational concert and sharing his musical journey as an immigrant from Peru. We provided these students and their families with complimentary tickets to our LATIN AMERICAN RHYTHMS concert. These personal interactions with students open their minds and expose them to new experiences that they may not have otherwise had. We held our first annual Mary G. Roebling Youth Concerto Competition.

in January, providing 15 area students with the opportunity to audition and receive feedback from our distinguished panel of judges. Our winner, Angela Zhang, was given the honor of performing with the CPNJ chamber orchestra in March. We introduced a new chamber music concert series that brought CPNJ to other parts of Trenton. Each concert was enthusiastically received by both concertgoers and the communities where they were held.

Before every concert our Board Member and Rider professor Joel Phillips gave pre-concert lectures to enhance the audience's experience by giving them a deeper understanding of the music. If you haven't had the opportunity to attend one of these informative lectures, please look for them in our upcoming season! We provided complimentary tickets to our concerts to some of Trenton's community enrichment organizations including Culture is K.E.Y. and The Father Center.

We are immensely proud of what we have been able to create with your help over the past decade; however, we cannot continue to do so without your support. During the 2022-2023 Season, CPNJ hosted Trenton Music Makers' most advanced orchestra prior to our March concert at the War Memorial. They were treated to a master class given by three of our musicians, had the opportunity to perform a curtain-raiser for our audience, and were all given a complimentary ticket to the concert.

In April our guitar soloist, David Galvez visited Trenton Music Makers after-school program, performed a short concert and talked to the students about his journey as a young musician, how he came to this country from Peru and what he has learned along the way. The students were very engaged and asked a lot of questions!

THE TRENTON CHILDREN'S CHORUS

CPNJ was able to provide an excellent experience for the Trenton Children's Chorus in our production of Nutcracker. They worked with Maestro Daniel Spalding in a rehearsal at their venue before the dress rehearsal at the War Memorial. Having the chance to sing with a professional orchestra for the American Repertory Ballet was certainly memorable for these young aspiring musicians.

International Charter School of Trenton was created to provide a quality elementary education for Trenton City residents. CPNJ has given many in-school programs to their students. This past season, we brought principal dancers from ARB along with 5 of our orchestra musicians and presented parts of the NUTCRACKER to their students. ARB's dance captain also worked with the students and taught them the basic positions in ballet! In addition, our guitar soloist, David Galvez visited the school and gave an educational concert/presentation. He spoke to the students about his musical journey, coming to the United States as an immigrant from Peru and answered their questions. At CPNJ, we feel that these interactions with students help to open their minds and identify with something they may not have otherwise been exposed to. We also provide the students and their families with complimentary tickets to our concerts.

THE FATHER CENTER

Building a foundation of hope for the future, The Father Center of New Jersey provides innovative programs and services to support men in meeting the responsibilities of fatherhood. CPNJ has provided complimentary concert tickets to this group so that families can enjoy our concerts together.

CULTURE IS KEY TRENTON

This organization was founded to build a personal and community wide expectation of excellent for young men and women of color ages 6-18, while raising their self-confidence and self-worth through mentorship-based programming. 


EXPERIENCE BEYOND THE SPACES

ARTWORKS

Trenton's downtown visual arts center, is a 501(c)(3) Charitable Corporation that promotes artistic diversity by fostering creativity, learning, and appreciation of the arts. We will partner with Artworks by providing live music at Art All Night at their next event. In addition, we are partnering with them for our TENTH Season opening night concert which will feature TEN local artists' works depicting the TEN movements of Mussorgsky's PICTURES AT AN EXHIBITION.

TRENTON CIRCUS SQUAD

Squad members learn physical techniques, life skills and build trust with teens from other neighborhoods. They lead community engagement through workshops and performances with younger children and families. A LEGACY OF SUPPORT

CPNJ recently received a donation from the Mary G. Roebling Foundation to start our endowment. This is an amazing and transformative gift that will support our work reaching out to the young people of Trenton and the region for decades to come. In addition, the Foundation gave us a \$13,000 challenge grant. If we raise \$13,000 in new donations dedicated to the endowment. This is an extraordinary opportunity for the orchestra.







About Mary G. Roebling

Mary G. Roebling (1905-1994) was a prominent and influential business leader, with contributions in the areas of finance, politics, women's rights, and philanthropy. Mrs. Roebling studied at the Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania – attending night classes because the University prohibited women from attending day classes. She was twice married and widowed at a young age. Mrs. Roebling went on to become the first woman to head a major US bank, when she became President of the Trenton Trust Company in 1937 at the age of 30. In Trenton, she had a \$500,000 townhouse built on State Street near her bank in 1959.

Her continued successes included her role as first woman governor of the American Stock Exchange in 1958, various roles in support of the US armed forces and the Army War College Foundation, civic, charitable and educational endeavors, and as a tireless advocate for a greater role for women in the country's economic affairs.




